Our Ministry is unique in that on a daily basis we reach out through ‘in person visits’ to those asking for help. We easily receive well over thirty calls a day for assistance.

The requests vary greatly as homelessness, loneliness, mental and physical health, addictions and lack of finances are big issues. The demands for our services therefore differ widely, as we cooperate with all relevant agencies. Requests range from help with grocery gift cards, toiletries, clothes, shoes, coats, diapers, bedding, formula, Ensure, bus tickets, eye glasses, small appliances etc. to assistance with the bureaucracy, funeral costs, dentures, hydro and rental payments.

Our registered charity is a totally volunteer organization. Nobody gets paid. We have little overhead and all our services are free, including the great many calls for furniture pickups and deliveries.

As during this Christmas Season, our hearts will be filled with peace, hope and joy, may we be able to “share the wealth” with those living on the margin in the realization that, in the words of St. Francis, it is “in giving that we receive.”

Due to the increase costs of everything from food, to clothing, to furniture, our charity is being called upon more often, and in many cases from people in desperate need.

Our charity is unique in that we go directly to those in need. Nobody is paid, all our work is done on a volunteer basis. You may have seen our minivan heading out to do daily visits, handing out food vouchers, clothing, or offering assistance with such things as dental work or rent. We go out every Monday to pick up donated furniture(see phone number below) and deliver that same furniture, the same day, to recipients that have called for help. The most requested items being mattresses, complete beds, dressers and small couches, and any other small furniture that often goes to someone that is starting out, with nothing.
